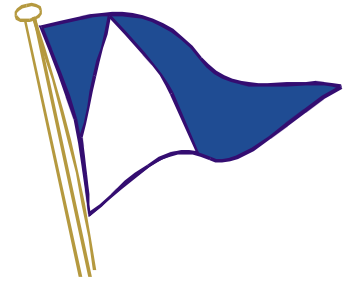




Great South Bay Catboat Rendezvous

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the *Rules* as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2. ENTRIES

Competitors may enter by delivering a completed entry form to the Sayville Yacht Club on or before the day of the event.

3. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located in the Club House.

4. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

Signals made ashore will be displayed from the Sayville Yacht Club flagpole.

When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 30 minutes' in race signal AP.

5. SCHEDULE

A competitors' meeting will be held at 1100 in the Sayville Yacht Club.

The warning signal for the first race will be .

Two races are scheduled, with the second race following the first, as soon as practicable.

6. CLASS FLAGS & STARTING ORDER

Classes will start in the following order using the class flags indicated:

Handicap - Over 19'	Red Flag
Handicap - 19' and Under	Blue Flag
Herrshoff America	Yellow Flag
Marshall 18	Red Flag

The grouping, number of classes and starting order is dependent upon on attendance and may be adjusted at the Skipper's Meeting or by a Notice to Competitors.

7. RACING AREA

The racing area will be the waters of the Great South Bay off Sayville Yacht Club.

8. COURSE and MARKS

The diagram on page 2 shows the course, the marks in order and the rounding direction of each mark.

Marks shall be inflatable buoys.

9. STARTING SYSTEM

The starting system of rule 26 will be used.

10. STARTING AND FINISHING LINES

The starting and finishing lines will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the committee boat at the starboard end and a red inflatable buoy at the port end.

11. TIME LIMIT

The time limit for each race will be 2 hours for the first boat in each class to finish. Boats failing to finish within 30 minutes after the first boat in her class sails the course and finishes will be scored 1+ the number of finishers. The RC reserves the right to score the last boat of a class in her place before finishing to expedite the start of another race. This changes rule 35.

12. PROTESTS

Protests shall be delivered to the Protest Committee within 30 minutes after the race committee boat docks. A list of protests received will be posted on the notice board to inform competitors. Hearings will be held as soon as possible after racing.

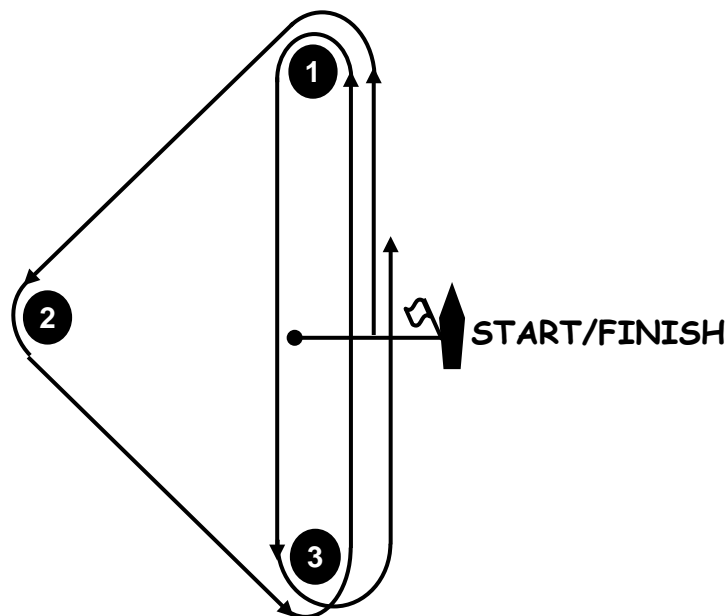
13. SCORING

The Low Point System of Appendix A of the racing rules will apply except that no scores will be excluded which changes rule A2. Two races are scheduled. One race constitutes a series.

14. TROPHIES

Trophies will be awarded to the top finishers at the dinner party at the Sayville Yacht Club on the day of the regatta.
