1. Rules

The races will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing for 2017-2020 except as amended by the sailing instructions.

2. Eligibility

The Opti Dinghy Fleet is invited to participate in the Wet Pants Junior Regatta, July 7, 2013. The Regatta is open to all other classes. A fleet of three or more boats will receive their own start all other boats will be assigned to a handicap fleet.

3. Fees

There is no fee for this regatta or for the post race refreshments.

4. Schedule

Registration 0800-0930

Coffee, Juice, Bagels and Donuts will be provided.

Competitors Meeting 0930

First Warning 1030

Subsequent races will follow as soon as possible after the conclusion of the previous race.

There will be no break for lunch. Bottled water will be available on courses

No Races will be started after 1500.

We Will Attempt to get in five races on each course, however, the completion of two races will constitute a regatta.

Post Race Refreshments will be provided.

5. Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions will be available at the registration table. Changes to the sailing instructions will be posted on the official Wet Pants Sailing Association Black Board in the main Room on the day of the regatta. Oral instructions may be given on the water as necessary from the committee boat or an official support boat.

6. Venue

Racing will be conducted in the waters immediately Southwest of Port-O-Call.

7. The Courses

Courses will be designated by a number posted from the committee boat and/or hailed orally.

Course 2. Windward-Leeward, Windward Finish

Course 3. Triangle, Windward Finish

Course 4. Windward-Leeward, Twice Around, Windward Finish.

Course 5. Triangle Windward-Leeward, Windward Finish.

Course 6. Triangle, Twice Around, Windward Finish.

8. Scoring

The Low-Point Scoring System will be used for this regatta. When five races have been completed, a boat's score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

9. Prizes

Prizes will be awarded to the first, second and third place boats

10. Safety

Competitors shall wear USCG approved PFD's at all times on and near the water.

11. Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. Wet Pants Sailing Association will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
